

TOWN BOARD MEETING

PRESENT: Councilpersons: Leonard Govern, Patty Wood, Supervisor Bruce Dolph, and Town Clerk Ronda Williams

ABSENT: Kevin Armstrong, Luis Rodriguez-Betancourt

OTHERS PRESENT: Ron Galley- The Walton Reporter,

Supervisor Dolph called the meeting to order.

The Board reviewed a Short Environmental Assessment Form Parts 1 and 2 for the purpose of determining an environmental quality assessment review of the Walton Reporter Building demolition project

Supervisor Dolph stated that the demolition will start on Monday, July 27, 2015.

Supervisor Dolph thanked Code Enforcement Officer Stephen Dutcher for all of his help during this project. Councilwoman Wood questioned how Mr. Dutcher contributed? Supervisor Dolph stated that he was the one who overseen and supervised other agencies during the cleanup of the contents within the building as well as the distribution of the bid contents.

Supervisor Dolph stated that he has been working with Commissioner Wayne Reynolds about having access through the County property to help divert water until the Water Street property project starts.

It was determined that there was no negative impact to the environment.

A motion was made by Councilman Govern, seconded by Wood granting Supervisor Dolph permission to sign the Short Environmental Assessment Forms Part 1 & Part 2 declaring there is not an environmental impact with the demolition of the Walton Reporter Building. All in favor, motion carried.

Councilwoman Wood questioned where the contents would be taking too. Supervisor Dolph explained that all demolition material will be hauled to the Seneca landfill at the expense of the County.

Councilwoman Wood questioned the village's role in this project? Supervisor Dolph stated that due to grant requirements, the land must stay in the Town's name for 5 years.

Councilwoman Wood suggested having the green area dedicated to veterans.

With no further business before the Board, the meeting was adjourned at 1:15 p.m.
