#### Agreement for the Expenditure of Highway Moneys 2023

AGREEMENT between the Town Superintendent of the Town of Walton, Delaware County, New York, and the undersigned members of the Town Board.

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 284 of the Highway Law, we agree that moneys levied and collected in the Town for the repair and improvement of highways, and received from the State for State Aid for the repair and improvement of highways, shall be expended as follows:

- 1. GENERAL REPAIRS. The sum of \$500,000 shall be set aside to be expended for primary work and general repairs upon 97.62 miles of town highways, including sluices, culverts and bridges having a span of less than five feet and boardwalks or renewals thereof.
- 2. PERMANENT IMPROVEMENTS. The following sums shall be set aside to be expended for the permanent improvement of Town highways:
  - (a) On the road commencing at County Highway #23 and leading to Dead End, a distance of .85 miles, there shall be expended not over the sum of \$15,000.00 Type Resurface, Width of traveled surface 16', Thickness 1" Single Surface Chip Seal Subbase Bill Finch Road (b) On the road commencing at <u>Town Line</u> and leading to <u>Town Line</u>, a distance of <u>1.2</u> miles, there shall be expended not over the sum of \$43,000.00. Type Resurface, Width of traveled surface 16', Thickness 2" Double Surface Chip Seal Subbase (Chase Brook Road) (c) On the road commencing at <u>State Route #10</u> and leading to <u>Dead End</u>, a distance of <u>.20</u> miles, there shall be expended not over the sum of \$3,500.00.
