PURPOSE OR GENERAL IDEA OF BILL:

This bill would require municipalities where real property tax exemptions may exist to notify eligible senior citizens of the tax exemptions they may be eligible to receive.

SUMMARY OF PROVISIONS:

Section 1 amends the Real Property Tax Law, Section 467, Subdivision 4 to require a second copy of the exemption notice to be sent thirty days before the filing deadline. Section 2 sets the effective date.

In most towns the tentative assessment roll is made public on May 1. The tentative roll lists assessment information for every property for the current year. It is your responsibility to check your assessment and exemptions on the tentative roll after it has been filed. Questions about your assessment should be directed to your assessor. After meeting with your assessor, if you are still dissatisfied, you have the right to file for a formal review by your Board of Assessment Review by the filing deadline.

A: SWIS (State Wide Information System)

A six-digit number assigned by the State as a unique identifier for every municipality in the state. The first two digits define the county, the second two the city or town, and the last pair the village, if any.

B: Uniform percentage of market value

New York State law requires that all properties in a municipality be assessed at the same percentage of market value. In this case, 95% means that the municipality is assessing property at 95% percent of market value.

C: Valuation date

G: Land assessment

The assessed value of the land without the addition of improvements (permanent structures). By law, only the total assessment (H) may be reviewed (or grieved).

H: Total assessment

The total assessed value of the property, including the land and improvements.

I: Full market value

What a willing buyer would pay a willing seller under normal circumstances. This should approximate the dollar amount for which the property could be sold. In places where the uniform percent of market value is 100%, this is the same as the assessed value; otherwise market value multiplied by the uniform percentage of value (B) will be the total assessed value (H).

J: Exemption

The name of the exemption and the exemption code (in this case Basic STAR 41854), followed by the amount of the exemption for each taxing jurisdiction (i.e., STAR B is the Basic STAR exemption and applies only to school tax, thus the taxable value of the exemption for county and city is zero).

K: Tax description

Taxing jurisdictions include counties, cities, towns, school districts, villages and special districts (fire, sewer, water, etc.)

Taxable value

The value, after exemptions are applied, upon which your tax bill will be calculated (H minus J = K). In this case, the school taxable value is different from the others due to the STAR exemption.

L: Assessor's oath

This is only listed on the last page of the roll. The assessor signs the roll to indicate that all assessments are uniform at the stated percentage of market value.

RESOLUTION #

TO DEDICATED A MEMORIAL PLAQUE IN HONOR OF LIUTENANT STEPHEN H. DOANE TO BE PLACE AT VETERANS PLAZA

WHEREAS, Stephen H. Doane was born 13 October 1947 and a resident of Walton, New York and a graduate of Walton Central School;

WHEREAS, In March of 1969, while serving in the Republic of Vietnam as a platoon leader, his company engaged in a tactical operation, abruptly contacted an enemy force concealed in protected bunkers and trenches. Three of his leading soldiers were pinned down by enemy crossfire and one was seriously wounded. After efforts of one platoon to rescue these men had failed, it became obvious that only a small group could successfully move close enough to destroy the enemy position and rescue the trapped soldiers. Lieutenant Doane although fully aware of the danger of such an action, crawled to the nearest enemy bunker and silenced it. He was wounded but continued to advance to a second enemy bunker. As he prepared to throw a grenade, he was again wounded. Undaunted, he deliberately pulled the pin on the grenade and lunged with it into the enemy bunker, destroying this final obstacle. Lieutenant Doane's supreme act enabled his company to rescue the trapped men without further casualties. The extraordinary courage and selflessness displayed by this officer were an inspiration to his men and are in the highest traditions of the U.S. Army;

WHEREAS, Lieutenant Stephen H. Doane from Walton, New York was posthumously awarded the Congressional Medal of Honor. Lieutenant Doane is the only Medal of Honor recipient from Delaware County;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town of Walton will place a memorial plaque in his honor at Veterans Plaza on July 22, 2022. By doing so, would be a lasting tribute to his memory and a permanent token of his service to the Country he loved;
