

Hello this is Walton Supervisor Joseph Cetta. First, thank you to all of our residents who have maintained the social distancing and handwashing regulations that have been promoted by the President, Governor and local Officials.

You may have heard on the news that there may be a positive trend with decreasing number of cases, please pray this trend continue. However, this is no time to celebrate. I'm sure it will take some time to get to the numbers the Governor will feel comfortable with before adjustments are made with the required social distancing order.

As we continue to live in this uncertain and unpredictable time the Town Board wanted to give you an update on information, we have from the Del Co Public Health briefings.

Delaware County personnel continue to monitor the COVID-19 pandemic around the clock. As of today, there are 42 confirmed positive cases of COVID-19 reported to Delaware County. There are an additional 42 people under mandatory quarantine and 6 people under precautionary quarantine. To date 248 people have been tested. Of those we are still waiting for results from 18 tests and we have received 189 negative test results. In addition, 5 confirmed cases have been transferred out of the county to where the person actually resides. Of the 36 confirmed positive cases in Delaware County 8 are isolated and receiving medical care in a hospital, 22 are isolated and recovering safely at their homes, 1 person is deceased and 5 have fully recovered and are no longer in isolation.
